- Assess PM Maturity: Identify gaps and areas for improvement, consider professionalisation as a broad stroke toward improvement
- Invest in Professionalisation: Support development through mentorship, financial aid for certifications, and knowledge sharing.
- **Collaborate with PM Bodies**: Partner with recognized organizations to align with industry standards.
- Integrate into Recruitment: Prioritize certifications and professional affiliations during hiring.
- Adopt Standards: Embed methodologies from professional PM bodies for consistency and quality.
- **Communicate Preferences**: Clearly outline preferred standards and certifications to guide project managers' professional growth.
